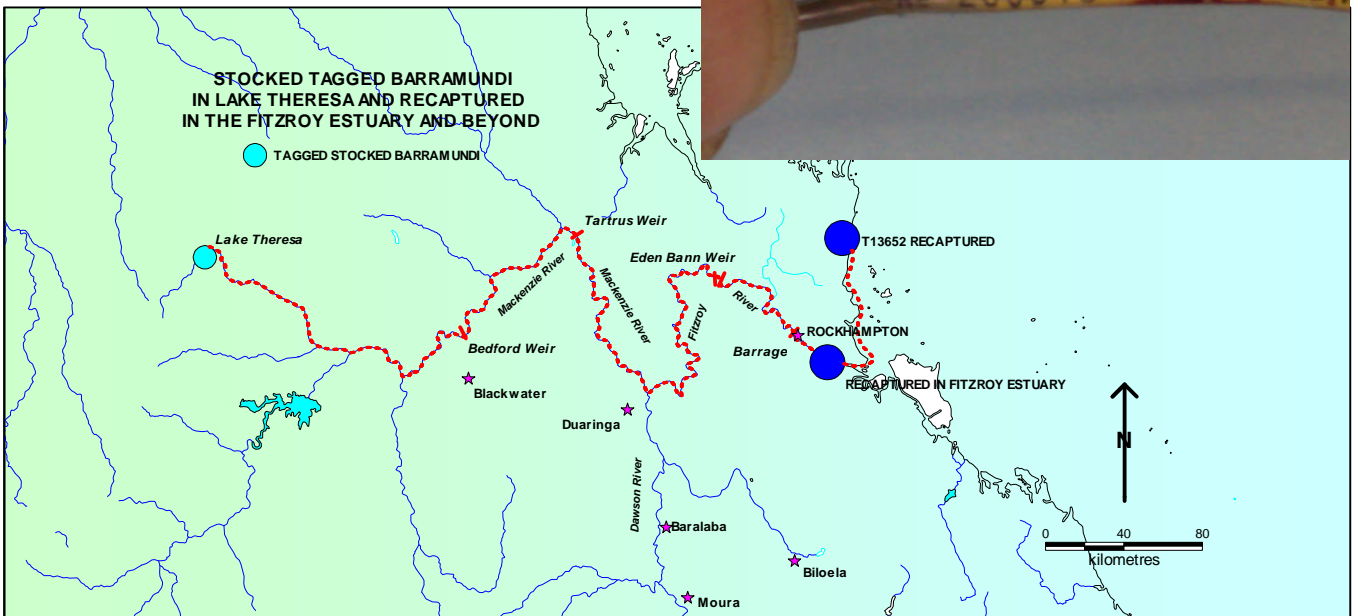

The Clermont Fish Stocking Group tagged and stocked 850 Barramundi ranging from around 300-500mm into Lake Theresa in November 2007. Since then 23 fish have been recaptured in the saltwater in the Fitzroy River estuary some 700-750km down river. This fish has gone one better and left the Fitzroy and travelled north to Corio Bay.
