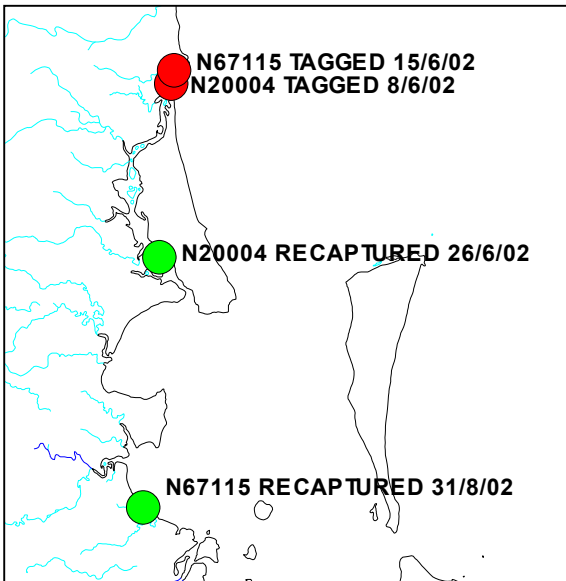

Suntag has passed another milestone by passing the 300,000 mark for fish tagged with over 25,500 recaptures. This has been accomplished since 1986/87 when ANSA Qld took over management of the program. It is also important to acknowledge the continued support of the Queensland Fisheries Service in funding Suntag. Infofish Services has received a grant of almost \$72,000 to manage Suntag for 2002/03 on behalf of ANSA Qld.
